The following preamble and resolution were offered by _____ and supported by _____.

WHEREAS, the Federal Forfeitures Fund is required for local units of government participating in the Justice Department Equitable Sharing Program. This fund is subject to laws, rules, regulations, and orders of the local jurisdiction governing the use of public funds; and

WHEREAS, the authorized expenditures include expenses of seizure, forfeiture and sale of property. The balance remaining must be used to enhance law enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the cash and investments of the Federal Forfeitures Fund are subject to the requirements of 1943 PA 20, MCL 129.91 and may be included in pooled cash and investment accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Forfeitures Fund must operate only with an adopted budget by the governing body of the local unit as required by 1968 PA 2, MCL 141.421 to MCL 141.440a; and

WHEREAS, all claims the county or local unit board pursuant to MCL 41.75 must approve (expenditures);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Board will approve separate Special Revenue Fund 262, Federal Forfeiture Fund effective January 1, 2020.
