Review of Notable Crime Activities February 1, 2021 – February 28, 2021

- > Zero (0) Homicides occurred this February, as well as last February. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time last year. (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- > Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this February compared to zero (0) last February showing an increase of 200%. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 33.33% (2 this year compared to 3 last year).
- > Zero (0) Robberies occurred this February compared to three (3) last February showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, robberies have decreased 75% this year compared to the same time last year (1 this year compared to 4 last year).
- ➤ Seven (7) Aggravated Assault occurred this February compared to four (4) last February showing an increase of 75%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 33.33% this year compared to the same time last year (8 this year compared to 6 last year).

- ➤ One (1) Burglary Residential occurred this February compared to four (4) last February showing a decrease of 75%. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 75% this year from the same time last year (1 this year compared to 4 last year).
- ➤ One (1) Burglary All Other occurred this February compared to zero (0) last February showing an increase of 100%. YTD, Burglaries All Other have increased by 50% this year compared to the same time last year (3 this year compared to 2 last year).
- ➤ Nine (9) Larcenies occurred this February compared to ten (10) last February showing a decrease of 10%. YTD, larcenies have decreased 21.74% this year compared to the same time last year (18 this year compared to 23 last year).
- ➤ Seventeen (17) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this February compared to four (4) last February showing an increase of 325%. YTD, larcenies from vehicles increased 183.33% this year from the same time last year (34 this year compared to 12 last year).
- ➤ Four (4) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this February compared to one (1) last February showing an increase of 300%. YTD, MVT increased 71.43% this year from the same time last year (12 this year compared to 7 last year).
- ➤ Nine (9) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this February compared to seven (7) last February showing an increase of 28.57%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 58.33% this year compared to the same time last year (19 this year compared to 12 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 35.71% this February (9) compared to last February (14). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 32% this year from the same time last year (17 this year compared to 25 last year).
- ➤ Three (3) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this February compared to ten (10) last February showing a decrease of 70%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 56.25% this year from the same time last year (7 this year compared to 16 last year).
