### **Review of Notable Crime Activities April 1, 2021 – April 30, 2021**

- Zero (0) Homicides occurred this April, as well as last April. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time last year. (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- One (1) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offense occurred this April, as well as last April. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 42.86% (4 this year compared to 7 last year).
- Two (2) Robberies occurred this April compared to zero (0) last April showing an increase of 100%. YTD, robberies have decreased 20% this year compared to the same time last year (4 this year compared to 5 last year).
- Three (3) Aggravated Assaults occurred this April compared to one (1) last April showing an increase of 200%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 18.18% this year compared to the same time last year (13 this year compared to 11 last year).

- One (1) Burglary – Residential occurred this April compared to two (2) last April showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 50% this year from the same time last year (4 this year compared to 8 last year).
- Three (3) Burglaries – All Other occurred this April compared to one (1) last April showing an increase of 200%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have increased 60% this year compared to the same time last year (8 this year compared to 5 last year).
- Twelve (12) Larcenies occurred this April compared to seven (7) last April showing an increase of 71.43%. YTD, larcenies have increased 13.89% this year compared to the same time last year (41 this year compared to 36 last year).
- Seven (7) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this April compared to eleven (11) last April showing a decrease of 36.36%. YTD, larcenies from vehicles increased 92.31% this year from the same time last year (50 this year compared to 26 last year).
- Three (3) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this April compared to one (1) last April showing an increase of 200%. YTD, MVT increased 88.89% this year from the same time last year (17 this year compared to 9 last year).
- Six (6) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this April compared to five (5) last April showing an increase of 20%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 11.11% this year compared to the same time last year (30 this year compared to 27 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations increased 566.67% this April (20) compared to last April (3). YTD, drug/narcotic violations increased 52.63% this year from the same time last year (58 this year compared to 38 last year).
- Seven (7) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this April compared to two (2) last April showing an increase of 250%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 22.22% this year from the same time last year (21 this year compared to 27 last year).
