## **Monthly Activity Report**

### **Review of Notable Crime Activities June 1, 2021 – June 30, 2021**

- One (1) Homicide occurred this June compared to zero (0) last June showing an increase of 100%. YTD, homicides have increased 100% this year compared to the same time last year. (1 this year compared to 0 last year).
- Three (3) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this June compared to one (1) last June showing an increase of 200%. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 10% (9 this year compared to 10 last year).
- Zero (0) Robberies occurred this June, as well as last June. YTD, robberies have decreased 28.57% this year compared to the same time last year (5 this year compared to 7 last year).
- Seven (7) Aggravated Assaults occurred this June compared to five (5) last June showing an increase of 40%. YTD, aggravated assaults have remained the same this year compared to the same time last year (21 this year compared to 21 last year).

- Two (2) Burglaries – Residential occurred this June compared to zero (0) last June showing an increase of 200%. YTD, residential burglaries have remained the same this year from the same time last year (8 this year compared to 8 last year).
- Two (2) Burglaries – All Other occurred this June compared to one (1) last June showing an increase of 100%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have increased 71.43% this year compared to the same time last year (12 this year compared to 7 last year).
- Thirteen (13) Larcenies occurred this June, as well as last June. YTD, larcenies have increased 21.43% this year compared to the same time last year (68 this year compared to 56 last year).
- Thirteen (13) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this June compared to four (4) last June showing an increase of 225%. YTD, larcenies from vehicles increased 92.11% this year from the same time last year (73 this year compared to 38 last year).
- Zero (0) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this June, as well as last June. YTD, MVT increased 38.46% this year from the same time last year (18 this year compared to 13 last year).
- Eleven (11) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this June compared to eight (8) last June showing an increase of 37.5%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 6.98% this year compared to the same time last year (46 this year compared to 43 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations increased 66.67% this June (15) compared to last June (9). YTD, drug/narcotic violations increased 28.99% this year from the same time last year (89 this year compared to 69 last year).
- Seven (7) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this June compared to two (2) last June showing an increase of 250%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 5.56% this year from the same time last year (34 this year compared to 36 last year).
