DRIVEWAYS AND ENTRANCES TO BUILDINGS, REAL PROPERTY, AND THE LIKE SHALL NOT BE BLOCKED EXCEPT FOR SHORT DURATIONS AND ONLY WHEN APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER. VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO COORDINATE ALL NECESSARY DRIVEWAY CLOSURES WITH THE PROPERTY OWNER(S) AND RESIDENT(S) IN THE AREAS OF CONSTRUCTION.

2. THE LOCATION AND DEPTH OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND SERVICE LEADS ARE TO BE FIELD VERIFIED BY THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.

3. LOCATION AND DEPTH OF UTILITIES AS DEPICTED ON THE PLANS IS APPROXIMATE AND SHOWN ACCORDING TO THE BEST INFORMATION AVAILABLE. IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO EXCAVATE AROUND AND ADJUST DEPTH OF CONFLICT UTILITY ACCORDINGLY. ANY DAMAGE TO UTILITIES IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO AVOID AND/OR REPAIR AS NECESSARY.

4. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO TAKE SPECIAL CARE TO PROTECT THE EXISTING WATER MAIN AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING CONSTRUCTION ACCESS TO THE MAIN AT ALL TIMES.

5. DURING NON-WORKING HOURS NO TRENCH SHALL REMAIN OPEN; ANY OPEN TRENCH SHALL BE PROPERLY SECURED WITH PROTECTIVE FENCING. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ITEM OF WORK "GENERAL CONDITIONS".

6. POSTAL DELIVERY AND REFUSE PICKUP SERVICE SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES BY THE CONTRACTOR.

7. WHERE STREET CURBS ARE UNDAUNED DUE TO CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, THEY SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTINUOUS MAINTENANCE OF THE TEMPORARY ROAD SURFACE AND SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA UNTIL THE FULL COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ITEM OF WORK "GENERAL CONDITIONS".

ALL CURB, SIDEWALK, DRIVEWAY APPROACH REMOVALS SHALL BE APPROVED BY ENGINEER BEFORE THE WORK IS DONE.

10. SAWED SEWER PIPE CONNECTIONS SHALL BE COUPLED WITH A FERNCO FLEXIBLE COUPLING AND A STAINLESS STEEL SHEAR RING.

11. THE LOCATION OF MATERIAL, STOCK PILES AND ON-SITE STAGING AREAS TO BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

12. PAYMENT FOR DRAINAGE STRUCTURE SUMPS, WHERE SPECIFIED, SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE PAYMENT FOR THE VARIOUS DRAINAGE STRUCTURES.

13. WHERE SEWER PIPS OF DIFFERENT SIZES OR MATERIALS ARE JOINED, FERNCO FLEXIBLE COUPLINGS WITH STAINLESS STEEL SHEAR RINGS SHALL BE USED. THE CONTRACTOR'S PURCHASE PRICE FOR THESE DEVICES, INCLUDING SHIPPING, SHALL BE PAID AS AN ADDITIONAL ITEM OF WORK. APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACTOR'S PURCHASE PRICE AND SHIPPING SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE PAYMENT FOR THE SEWER.

14. WHERE SEWER AND WATER MAINS ARE TO BE REMOVED OR REPLACED, ALL PIPE SHALL BE INSTALLED USING TRENCH DEPTHS AS SPECIFIED ON THE SPECIFICATIONS AND SHOWN PLANS. BACKFILL FOR SEWER AND WATER CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE MOIST GRANULAR MATERIAL, CLASS 3, MODIFIED.

15. EXISTING STREET NAME, DIXIE, AND REGULATORY SIGNS, AND MALIBUWOKS WHICH CONFLICT WITH THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REMOVED IN THE MANNER WHICH WILL PROTECT DAMAGE AND RE-SET IN LOCATIONS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN "MACHINE GRADING AND PAVING".

16. IN AREAS WHERE DEEP DRAIN CANNOT BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY OF ANN ARBOR DESIGN SD-10-11, THE DEEP DRAIN SHALL BE INSTALLED AT THE DEPTH AS INDICATED ON THE PLANS, OR AS DIRECTED BY ENGINEER. IN NO CASE SHALL THE DEEP DRAIN BE INSTALLED AT A GRADE LESS THAN 6.00% OR AT A DEPTH OF LESS THAN 3' BELOW TOP OF PROPOSED

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMPLEMENT AND MAINTAIN THE SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES AS SHOWN ON THE SPEC PLANS AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION ON THIS PROJECT. ANY MODIFICATIONS OR ADDITIONS TO THE SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES DUE TO CONSTRUCTION OR CHANGED CONDITIONS SHALL BE COMPLIED WITH AS REQUIRED OR DIRECTED BY THE OWNED PROJECT ENGINEER, OR PITTSFORD CHARTER TOWNSHIP ENGINEER.
2. ALL SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL WORK SHALL CONFORM TO THE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF PITTSFORD CHARTER TOWNSHIP AND THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN.
3. A NPDES CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL SITES GREATER THAN FIVE (5) ACRES.
4. DAILY INSPECTIONS SHALL BE MADE BY THE CONTRACTOR. PERIODIC INSPECTIONS MAY BE MADE BY THE OWNED/PROJECT ENGINEER/TOWNSHIP TO DETERMINE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL MEASURES. ANY NECESSARY CORRECTIONS SHALL BE MADE WITHOUT DELAY BY THE OWNERS RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUAL.
5. EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION FROM WORK ON THE SITE SHALL BE CONTAINED ON THE SITE AND NOT BE ALLOWED TO COLLECT ON ANY OFF-SITE AREAS OR IN WATERWAYS.
6. ALL MUD/DIRT TRACKED ONTO ROADS FROM THE SITE DUE TO CONSTRUCTION, SHALL BE PROMPTLY REMOVED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
7. RESTORATION OF ALL DISTURBED AREAS INCLUDING PLANTING OF TROPICAL, SEED, FERTILIZER AND MULCH AND SOIL SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN FIVE (5) DAYS OF THE COMPLETION OF FINAL GRADE.
8. CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS SHALL BE SCHEDULED AND PERFORMED SO THAT PREVENTATIVE SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES ARE IN PLACE PRIOR TO EXCAVATION IN CRITICAL AREAS. EROSION PREVENTATION STABILIZATION MEASURES ARE IN PLACE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING SHORTLING OPERATIONS.
9. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS WILL BE TAKEN IN THE USE OF CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT TO PREVENT SITUATIONS THAT PROMOTE EROSION.
10. PROPER DUST CONTROL SHALL BE MAINTAINED DURING CONSTRUCTION BY USE OF WATER TRUCKS AND/OR CHLORIDE AS REQUIRED.
11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING ALL TEMPORARY SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES AND REMOVAL OF SAME UPON AUTHORIZED COMPLETION OF PROJECT. COMPLETION OF PROJECT WILL NOT BE AUTHORIZED UNTIL ALL SITE WORK, HOME BUILDING, ROAD WORK, AND UTILITY CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE AND ALL SOILS ARE STABILIZED.
12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP GRADES OF EXISTING WETLANDS AND CONSERVATION AREAS TO BE PROTECTED, SOIL FENCING SHALL BE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED ADJACENT TO EXISTING WETLAND AND CONSERVATION AREAS TO PREVENT GRAZING, EROSION, AND SEDIMENTATION INTO THEM.
13. TREE PROTECTION FENCING MUST REMAIN INTACT UNTIL RESTORATION OF THE SITE IS COMPLETE.

1. INSTALL SEDIMENT FENCE AND TREE PROTECTION FENCING PRIOR TO ANY GRADING OPERATION.
2. INSTALL MUD TRACKING PAD.

3. CONSTRUCT TEMPORARY SEDIMENT/RETENTION BASIN.
  4. PLACE TOPSOIL, FERTILIZER, SEED, AND MULCH OVER THE ENTIRE DETENTION BASIN AREA.

  12. REMOVE ANY ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT WITHIN THE DETENTION BASIN AND REPLACE CLEAN WASHED STONE AROUND STANDPIPE.
  13. COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF SITE.
  14. ENSURE ALL SOIL IS STABILIZED. REMOVE ALL TEMPORARY SOIL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES.

1. SEED OR SOO IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS.
2. ALL AREAS OF DISTURBED EARTH THAT ARE NOT TO BE PAVED OR SOOEDd SHALL HAVE 4 INCHES OF TOPSOIL, SEED, FERTILIZER AND MULCH.
3. IMMEDIATELY AFTER SEEDING, MUCH ALL SEEDS AREAS WITH UNKATHENED SMALL GRAIN STRAW (PROBABLY WHEAT) OR ANY OTHER SPREAD UNIFORMLY AT THE RATE OF 1-1/2 TO 2 TONS OR 100 POUNDS (2 TO 3 BALES) PER 1,000 SQUARE FOOT. THIS MULCH SHOULD BE ANCHORED WITH A DISC-TYPE MULCH-ANCHORING TOOL.
4. ANY DISTURBED AREA NOT PAVED, SEEDED OR MULCHED, SOOEDD OR BUILT UPON ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 15TH, IS TO BE MULCHED IN THE MANNER AS SPECIFIED ABOVE, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SOIL EROSION PROTECTION DURING THE WINTER AND EARLY SPRING.
5. DESIGN AND SEEDMENTATION CONTROL PREVENTION PROCEDURES AND STRUCTURES ARE TO COMPLY WITH THE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL OF THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CONSTRUCTION.

- HI-FLOW SITSACK (FOR AREAS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY PRECIPITATION AND RUN-OFF).
- OIL-ABSORBANT SITSACK (FOR AREAS WHERE THERE IS A CONCERN FOR OIL RUN-OFF OR SPILLS).

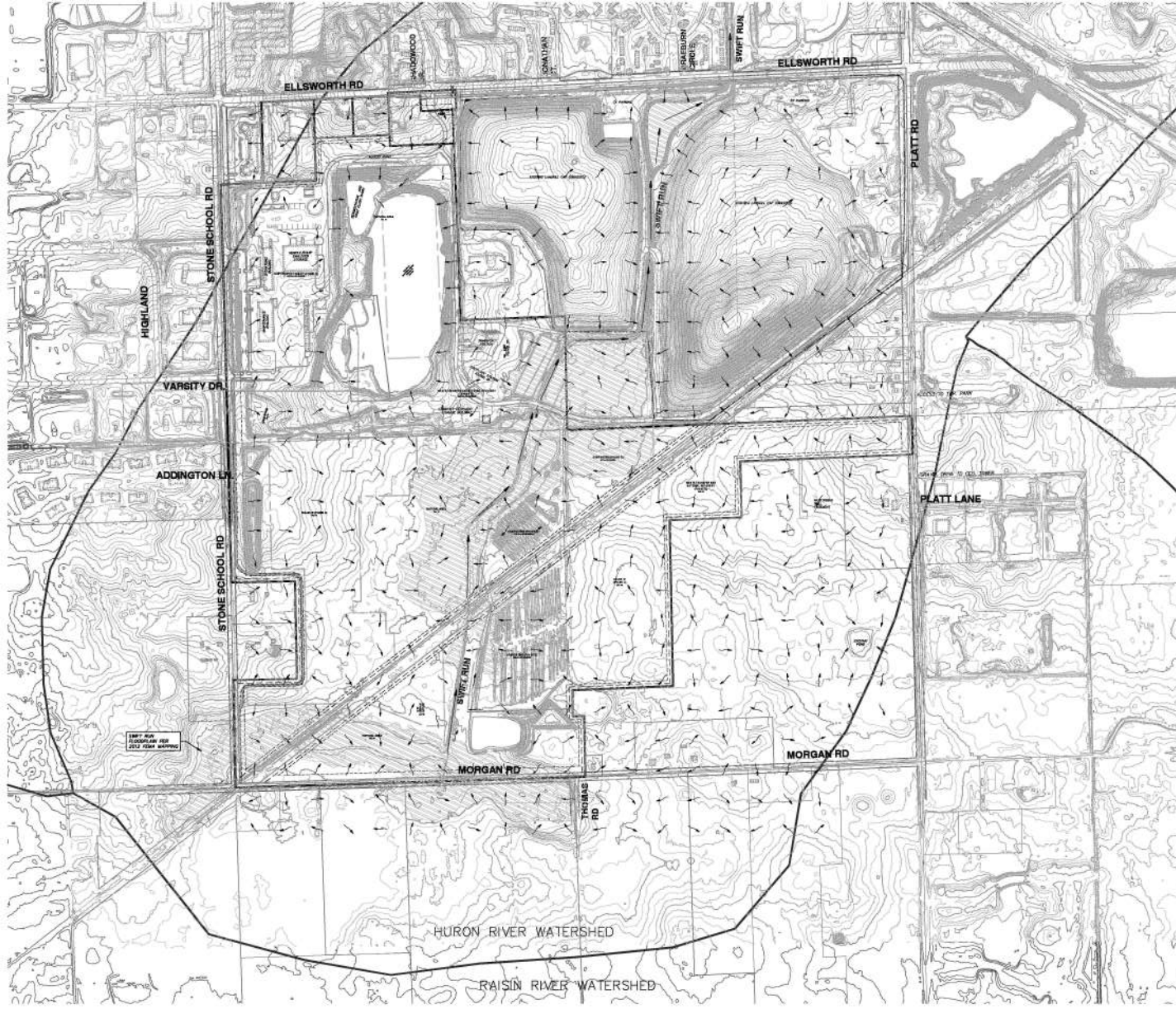

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE NATURAL FEATURES (2003)

##### GRASSLAND

THE AREAS IDENTIFIED AS "SOLAR 'A'" AND "SOLAR 'B'" ARE LOCATED ON TWO MAINTAINED GRASSLAND AREAS SEPARATED BY A FORMER RAILROAD. "SOLAR 'A'" IS LOCATED ON AN APPROXIMATELY 30-ACRE FIELD AND "SOLAR 'B'" IS LOCATED ON AN APPROXIMATELY 7-ACRE FIELD. THE TWO FIELDS SHARE SIMILAR VEGETATION AND APPEAR TO BE MAINTAINED WITH MOWING. THE GRASS SPECIES IDENTIFIED INCLUDES COMMON SPECIES GROWN FOR HAY PRODUCTION SUCH AS SMOOTH BROME (BROMUS INERMIS) AND TIMOTHY (PHLEUM PRATENSE). OTHER GRASS SPECIES IDENTIFIED ARE RED FESCUE (FESTUCA RUBRA) AND GREEN FORTAL (SETARIA FABER). "SOLAR 'A'" CONTAINS A NARROW WOODLOT, APPROXIMATELY 100-FEET WIDE, THAT TRANSECTS THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE FIELD. THIS WOODLOT CONTAINS MULTIPLE HICKORY SPECIES (CARYA LACINIOSA AND CARYA OVATA), COMMON BUCKTHORN (RHAMNUS CATHARTICA), RIVERBANK GRAPE (VITIS RIPARIA), YELLOW AGENS (CELANUS ALPESTRUM), AND COMMON SELF-HEAL (PRUNELLA VULGARIS).

##### AGRICULTURE FIELD

THE AREA IDENTIFIED AS "SOLAR 'C'" IS A 25-ACRE FIELD THAT IS PREDOMINANTLY IN ACTIVE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION. THE DOMINANT CROPS COVER CONSISTS OF CORN (ZEA MAYS) WITH SPARSE ANNUAL RAGWEED (AMBROSIA ARTEMISIIFOLIA). THIS FIELD IS SURROUNDED BY WINDBREAKS TO THE NORTH, WEST, AND SOUTH. AGRICULTURAL FIELDS ARE LOCATED TO THE EAST. THE WINDBREAKS ARE APPROXIMATELY 50-FEET AT THE WEST POINT. COMMON VEGETATION IDENTIFIED IN THESE WINDBREAKS CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING: SHAGBARK HICKORY (CARYA OVATA), COMMON BUCKTHORN (RHAMNUS CATHARTICA), BLACK WALNUT (JUGLANS NIGRA), RED OAK (QUERCUS RUBRA), HAWTHORN (CRATAEGUS CRUG-EGALLI), TARTARIAN HONEYSUCKLE (LONICERA TATARICA), SMOOTH BROME (BROMUS INERMIS), TALL GOLDENROD (SOLIDAGO ALTEISSIMA), AND MILD CARROT (Daucus CAROTA).

##### POND

THE AREA IDENTIFIED AS "SOLAR 'D'" FLOATING ARRAY" IS LOCATED IN AN APPROXIMATELY 19-ACRE POND. THE POND DISPLAYS SIGNS OF DISTURBANCE DUE TO THE ABUNDANCE OF COMMON REED (PHRAGMITES AUSTRALIS), PURPLE LODGEPOLE (LYTHRUM SALICARIA), AND SANDBAR WILLOW (SALIX EXOBA SUBSP. INTERIOR) GROWING IN THE SHALLOWER PORTIONS OF THE POND. OUTSIDE OF THE WETLAND FRINGE OF THE POND, THE UPLAND AREAS DISPLAY EVIDENCE OF NATIVE PLANT RESTORATION DUE TO THE PRESENCE OF SWITCHGRASS (PANICUM VIRGATUM), BIG BLUESTEM (ANDROPOGON GERARDI), INDIANGRASS (SORGHASTRUM NUTANS), AND LITTLE BLUESTEM (SPODOCHLOM SCOPARIUM). MIXED AMONG THE NATIVE GRASS SPECIES INCLUDES PLANTS COMMONLY FOUND IN DISTURBED AREAS SUCH AS COMMON BUCKTHORN (RHAMNUS CATHARTICA), EASTERN COTTONWOOD (POPULUS DELTOIDES), CHOCORY (CICHORIUM INTYBUS), AND TEASEL (EUPHASIA LADINATUS). HONEY LOCUST (GLYSTISIA TRIACANTHOS) IS PRESENT EAST OF THE POND. SIGNS ADJACENT NEAR THE POND INDICATE THAT THE AREA IS AN "AQUO CONSERVATION EASEMENT."

ALL AREAS IDENTIFIED ABOVE ARE LOCATED ON SLOPES THAT ARE LESS THAN 5% TREES THAT HAVE A DIAMETER AT BREAST HEIGHT (DBH) GREATER THAN 24-INCHES INCLUDE BLACK WALNUT AND RED OAK. TREES THAT HAVE A DBH BETWEEN 12- AND 24-INCHES INCLUDE THE HICKORY SPECIES. TREES WITH A DBH LESS THAN 12-INCHES INCLUDE COMMON BUCKTHORN, EASTERN COTTONWOOD, HONEY LOCUST, AND TARTARIAN HONEYSUCKLE.

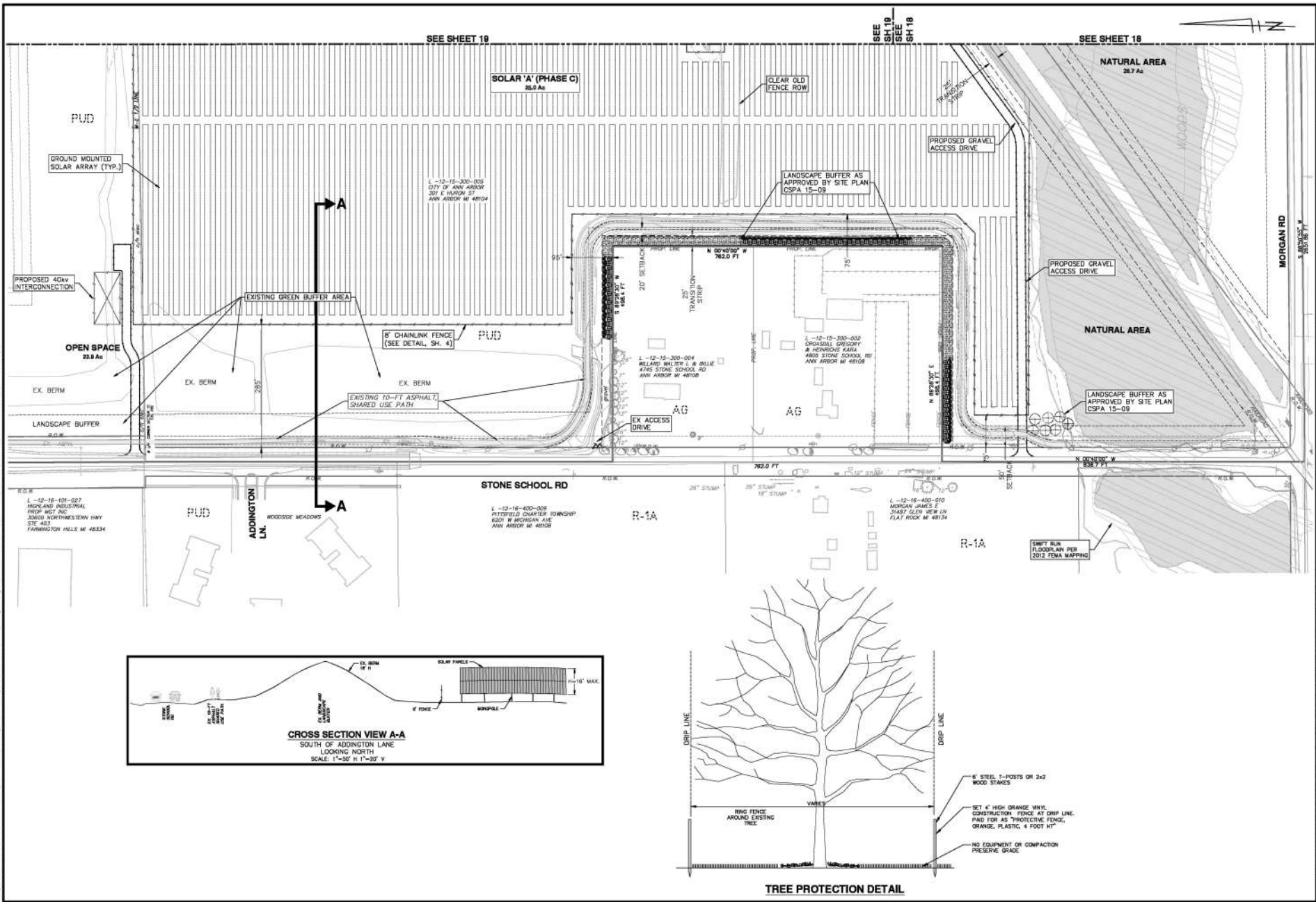

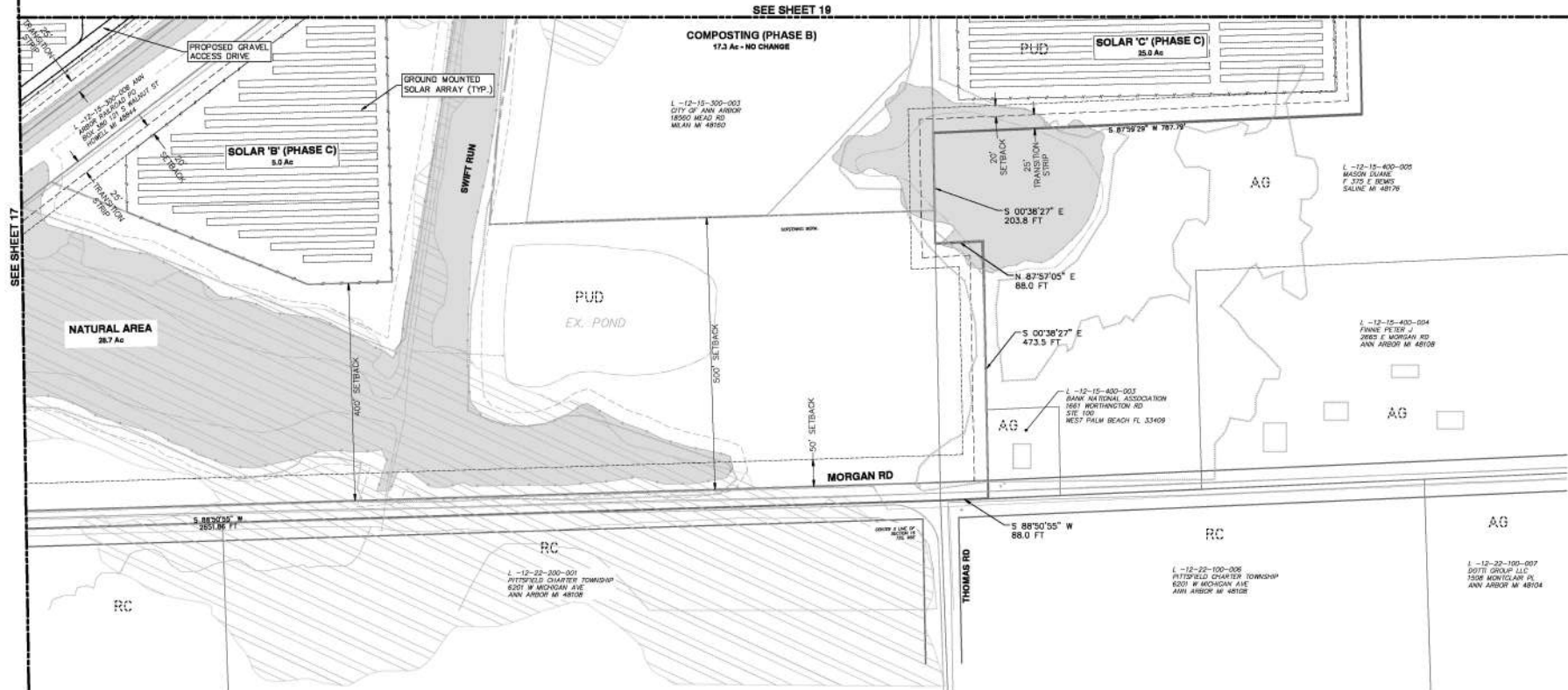

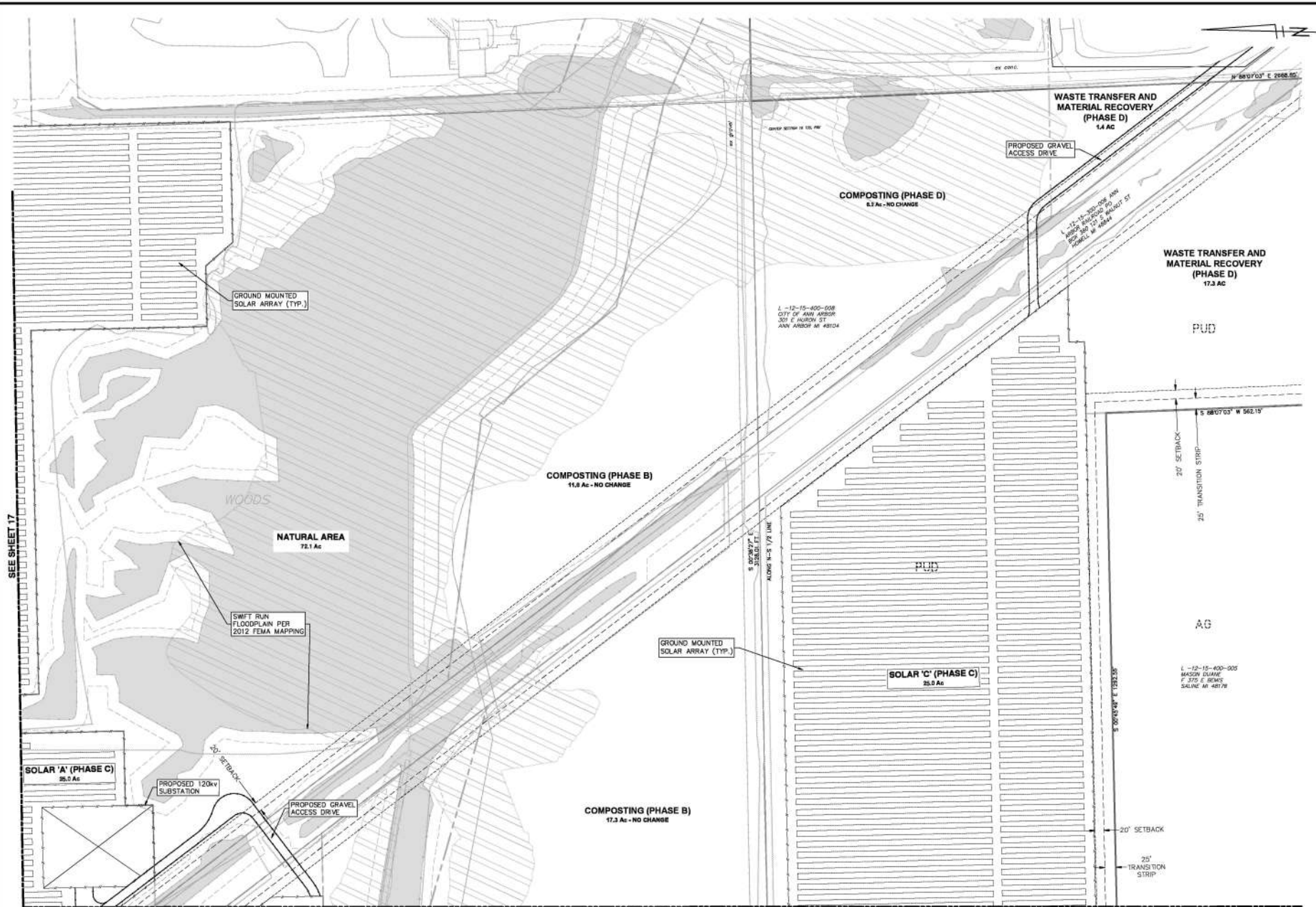
