### **Review of Notable Crime Activities August 1, 2021 – August 31, 2021**

Note: 2021 activity is compared to the activity of 2019 due to COVID-19

- Zero (0) Homicides occurred this August as well as August of 2019. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to 2019. (1 this year compared to 1 in 2019).
- Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this August compared to one (1) in August of 2019 showing an increase of 100%. YTD, CSC offenses have increased 50% this year compared to 2019 (15 this year compared to 10 in 2019).
- One (1) Robberies occurred this August compared to two (2) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, robberies have decreased 14.29% this year compared to 2019 (6 this year compared to 7 in 2019).
- Six (6) Aggravated Assaults occurred this August compared to four (4) in August of 2019, showing an increase of 50%. YTD, aggravated assaults have decreased 3.23% this year compared to 2019 (30 this year compared to 31 in 2019).

- Zero (0) Burglaries – Residential occurred this August compared to one (1) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 61.54% this year from the same time in 2019 (10 this year compared to 26 in 2019).
- One (1) Burglary – All Other occurred this August compared to three (3) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 66.67%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have remained the same this year compared to the same time in 2019 (13 this year compared to 13 in 2019).
- Eight (8) Larcenies occurred this August compared to nine (9) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 11.11%. YTD, larcenies have decreased 14 % this year compared to the same time in 2019 (86 this year compared to 100 in 2019).
- Sixteen (16) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this August compared to twenty-five (25) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 36%. YTD, larcenies from vehicles decreased 22.06% this year from the same time in 2019 (106 this year compared to 136 in 2019).
- Six (6) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this August compared to fifteen (15) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 60%. YTD, MVT decreased 41.30% this year from the same time in 2019 (27 this year compared to 46 in 2019).
- Six (6) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this August compared to nine (9) in August of 2019, showing a decrease of 33.33%. YTD, MDOP offenses have decreased 4.84% this year compared to the same time in 2019 (59 this year compared to 62 in 2019).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 23.08% this August (10) compared to August of 2019 (13). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 4.8% this year from the same time in 2019 (119 this year compared to 125 in 2019).
- Twelve (12) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this August compared to eight (8) in August of 2019, showing an increase of 50%. YTD, OUI arrests have increased 9.8% this year compared to the same time in 2019 (56 this year compared to 51 in 2019).
