### **Review of Notable Crime Activities February 1, 2022 – February 28, 2022**

- Zero Homicides occurred this February, as well as last February. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- Zero (0) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this February compared to two (2) last February showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, CSC offenses have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (2 this year compared to 2 last year).
- Zero (0) Robberies occurred this February, as well as last February. YTD, robberies have decreased 100% this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 1 last year).
- Seven (7) Aggravated Assaults occurred this February compared to six (6) last February showing an increase of 16.67%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 42.86% this year compared to the same time period last year (10 this year compared to 7 last year).

- Four (4) Burglaries – Residential occurred this February compared to one (1) last February showing an increase of 300%. YTD, Burglaries – Residential have increased 300% this year compared to the same time period last year (4 this year compared to 1 last year).
- Zero (0) Burglaries – All Other occurred this February compared to one (1) last February showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have decreased 100% this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 3 last year).
- Six (6) Larcenies occurred this February compared to ten (10) last February showing a decrease of 40%. YTD, Larcenies have decreased 26.32% this year compared to the same time period last year (14 this year compared to 19 last year).
- Ten (10) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this February compared to seventeen (17) last February showing a decrease of 41.18%. YTD, Larcenies from Vehicles have decreased 26.47% this year compared to the same time period last year (25 this year compared to 34 last year).
- Six (6) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this February compared to four (4) last February showing an increase of 50%. YTD, MVT offenses have increased 25% this year compared to the same time period last year (15 this year compared to 12 last year).
- Ten (10) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this February compared to nine (9) last February showing an increase of 11.11%. YTD, MDOP offenses have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (19 this year compared to 19 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 100% this February (0) compared to last February (11). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 42.1% this year from the same time period last year (11 this year compared to 19 last year).
- Two (2) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this February compared to three (3) last February showing a decrease of 33.33%. YTD, OUI arrests have increased 14.29% this year compared to the same time period last year (8 this year compared to 7 last year).
