TJs will remove leaf piles at roadside using our vacuum trailer and take to the area compost centers for recycling. Leaves need to be brought to roadside by the morning of the removal dates. Not in ditches, but as close to the roadside as possible. The leaf vacuum has about 6 feet of reach, and the tighter the piles the better. If we must do any moving of piles to roadside, we will skip the removal. We are available to help with cleanups, but with this many cleanups to do, the removal crews cannot spend time with extra leaf moving to get the leaves in the proper place for removal.

With the vacuum truck, we can remove leaves, no branches, no garden waste. If folks want to put separate piles of either at the curbside for removal on those days, I would be willing to take piles of those away. However, there will be an additional charge for removing branches and garden waste piles.

I would prefer to do the removals during the work week, as the compost centers are not open to us on the weekend. It will probably take us all of one day to do the removals, maybe two depending on how many we are doing. The dates are weather dependent, of course, and we can be a bit flexible on the dates.

Proposed schedules:

Two fall removals: early November, early December. \$125 per removal.

(Optional)

One spring removal in future years: \$125 per removal.
