Review of Notable Crime Activities June 1, 2022 – June 30, 2022

- > Zero Homicides occurred this June, as well as last June. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- > Zero (0) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this June compared to four (4) last June showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 30% this year compared to the same time period last year (7 this year compared to 10 last year).
- > Zero (0) Robberies occurred this June as well as last June. YTD, robberies have decreased 100% this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 5 last year).
- Five (5) Aggravated Assaults occurred this June compared to seven (7) last June showing a decrease of 28.57%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 33.33% this year compared to the same time period last year (28 this year compared to 21 last year).

- > Three (3) Burglaries Residential occurred this June compared to two (2) last June showing an increase of 50%. YTD, Burglaries Residential have increased 66.67% this year compared to the same time period last year (15 this year compared to 9 last year).
- ➤ Zero (0) Burglaries All Other occurred this June compared to two (2) last June showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, Burglaries All Other have decreased 83.33% this year compared to the same time period last year (2 this year compared to 12 last year).
- ➤ Ten (10) Larcenies occurred this June compared to thirteen (13) last June showing a decrease of 23.1%. YTD, Larcenies have decreased 5.88% this year compared to the same time period last year (64 this year compared to 68 last year).
- ➤ Twenty-four (24) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this June compared to thirteen (13) last June showing an increase of 84.62%. YTD, Larcenies from Vehicles have increased 20.55% this year compared to the same time period last year (88 this year compared to 73 last year).
- ➤ Eight (8) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this June compared to zero (0) last June showing an increase of 800%. YTD, MVT offenses have increased 133.33% this year compared to the same time period last year (42 this year compared to 18 last year).
- ➤ Nine (9) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this June compared to eleven (11) last June showing a decrease of 18.18%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 17.39% this year compared to the same time period last year (54 this year compared to 46 last year).
- ➤ Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 42.86% this June (8) compared to last June (14). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 44.32% this year from the same time period last year (49 this year compared to 88 last year).
- Four (4) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this June compared to seven (7) last June showing a decrease of 42.86%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 20.59% this year compared to the same time period last year (27 this year compared to 34 last year).
