Review of Notable Crime Activities July 1, 2022 – July 31, 2022

- Zero Homicides occurred this July, as well as last July. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- One (1) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offense occurred this July compared to four (4) last July showing a decrease of 75%. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 50% this year compared to the same time period last year (7 this year compared to 14 last year).
- One (1) Robbery occurred this July compared to zero (0) last July showing an increase of 100%. YTD, robberies have decreased 80% this year compared to the same time period last year (1 this year compared to 5 last year).
- Seven (7) Aggravated Assaults occurred this July compared to four (4) last July showing an increase of 75%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 36% this year compared to the same time period last year (34 this year compared to 25 last year).

- Three (3) Burglaries – Residential occurred this July compared to two (2) last July showing an increase of 50%. YTD, Burglaries – Residential have increased 63.64% this year compared to the same time period last year (18 this year compared to 11 last year).
- Two (2) Burglaries – All Other occurred this July compared to zero (0) last July showing an increase of 200%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have decreased 66.67% this year compared to the same time period last year (4 this year compared to 12 last year).
- Twenty-six (26) Larcenies occurred this July compared to thirteen (13) last July showing an increase of 100%. YTD, Larcenies have increased 8.64% this year compared to the same time period last year (88 this year compared to 81 last year).
- Eleven (11) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this July compared to sixteen (16) last July showing a decrease of 31.25%. YTD, Larcenies from Vehicles have increased 11.24% this year compared to the same time period last year (99 this year compared to 89 last year).
- Eight (8) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this July compared to three (3) last July showing an increase of 166.67%. YTD, MVT offenses have increased 128.57% this year compared to the same time period last year (48 this year compared to 21 last year).
- Seven (7) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this July as well as last July. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 15.1% this year compared to the same time period last year (61 this year compared to 53 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 36.84% this July (12) compared to last July (19). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 43.93% this year from the same time period last year (60 this year compared to 107 last year).
- Four (4) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this July compared to ten (10) last July showing a decrease of 60%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 29.55% this year compared to the same time period last year (31 this year compared to 44 last year).
