Review of Notable Crime Activities August 1, 2022 – August 31, 2022

- Zero Homicides occurred this August, as well as last August. YTD, homicides have remained the same this year compared to the same time period last year (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- One (1) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offense occurred this August compared to two (2) last August showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, CSC offenses have decreased 37.5% this year compared to the same time period last year (10 this year compared to 16 last year).
- Four (4) Robberies occurred this August compared to one (1) last August showing an increase of 300%. YTD, robberies have decreased 16.67% this year compared to the same time period last year (5 this year compared to 6 last year).
- Four (4) Aggravated Assaults occurred this August compared to six (6) last August showing a decrease of 33.33%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 16.13% this year compared to the same time period last year (36 this year compared to 31 last year).

- One (1) Burglary – Residential occurred this August compared to zero (0) last August showing an increase of 100%. YTD, Burglaries – Residential have increased 72.73% this year compared to the same time period last year (19 this year compared to 11 last year).
- Five (5) Burglaries – All Other occurred this August compared to one (1) last August showing an increase of 400%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have decreased 30.77% this year compared to the same time period last year (9 this year compared to 13 last year).
- Seventeen (17) Larcenies occurred this August compared to eight (8) last August showing an increase of 112.5%. YTD, Larcenies have increased 17.98% this year compared to the same time period last year (105 this year compared to 89 last year).
- Thirteen (13) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this August compared to sixteen (16) last August showing a decrease of 18.75%. YTD, Larcenies from Vehicles have increased 6.67% this year compared to the same time period last year (112 this year compared to 105 last year).
- Two (2) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this August compared to seven (7) last August showing a decrease of 71.43%. YTD, MVT offenses have increased 82.14% this year compared to the same time period last year (51 this year compared to 28 last year).
- Nine (9) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this August compared to six (6) last August showing an increase of 50%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 18.64% this year compared to the same time period last year (70 this year compared to 59 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 10% this August (9) compared to last August (10). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 41.03% this year from the same time period last year (69 this year compared to 117 last year).
- Four (4) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this August compared to twelve (12) last August showing a decrease of 66.67%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 37.5% this year compared to the same time period last year (35 this year compared to 56 last year).
