## Review of Notable Crime Activities April 1, 2023 – April 30, 2023

- Zero (0) Homicides occurred this April as well as last April. YTD, homicides have increased 100% this year compared to the same period last year (1 this year compared to 0 last year).
- Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this April compared to one (1) last April showing an increase of 100%. YTD, CSC offenses have increased 50% this year compared to the same period last year (6 this year compared to 4 last year).
- Zero (0) Robberies occurred this April as well as last April. YTD, robberies have increased 100% this year compared to the same period last year (1 this year compared to 0 last year).
- Seven (7) Aggravated Assaults occurred this April compared to three (3) last April showing an increase of 133.33%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 11.77% this year compared to the same period last year (19 this year compared to 17 last year).

- Two (2) Burglaries Residential occurred this April compared to three (3) last April showing a decrease of 33.33%. YTD, Burglaries Residential have decreased 11.11% this year compared to the same period last year (9 this year compared to 8 last year).
- One (1) Burglary All Other occurred this April compared to zero (0) last April showing an increase of 100%. YTD, Burglaries All Other have increased 200% this year compared to the same period last year (3 this year compared to 1 last year).
- Sixteen (16) Larcenies occurred this April compared to ten (10) last April showing an increase of 60%. YTD, Larcenies have increased 55.56% this year compared to the same period last year (56 this year compared to 36 last year).
- Twelve (12) Larcenies from Vehicles occurred this April compared to five (5) last April showing an increase of 140%. YTD, Larcenies from Vehicles have increased 29.55% this year compared to the same period last year (57 this year compared to 44 last year).
- Nine (9) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this April compared to two (2) last April showing an increase of 350%. YTD, MVT offenses have decreased 15.38% this year compared to the same period last year (22 this year compared to 26 last year).
- Ten (10) Malicious Damage to Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this April compared to eight (8) last April showing an increase of 25%. YTD, MDOP offenses have decreased 2.70% this year compared to the same period last year (36 this year compared to 37 last year).
- Two (2) Drug/Narcotic violations occurred this April compared to twelve (12) last April showing a decrease of 83.33%. YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 10.34% this year from the same period last year (26 this year compared to 29 last year).
- Six (6) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this April compared to three (3) last April showing an increase of 100%. YTD, OUI arrests have increased 39.89% this year compared to the same period last year (25 this year compared to 18 last year).
